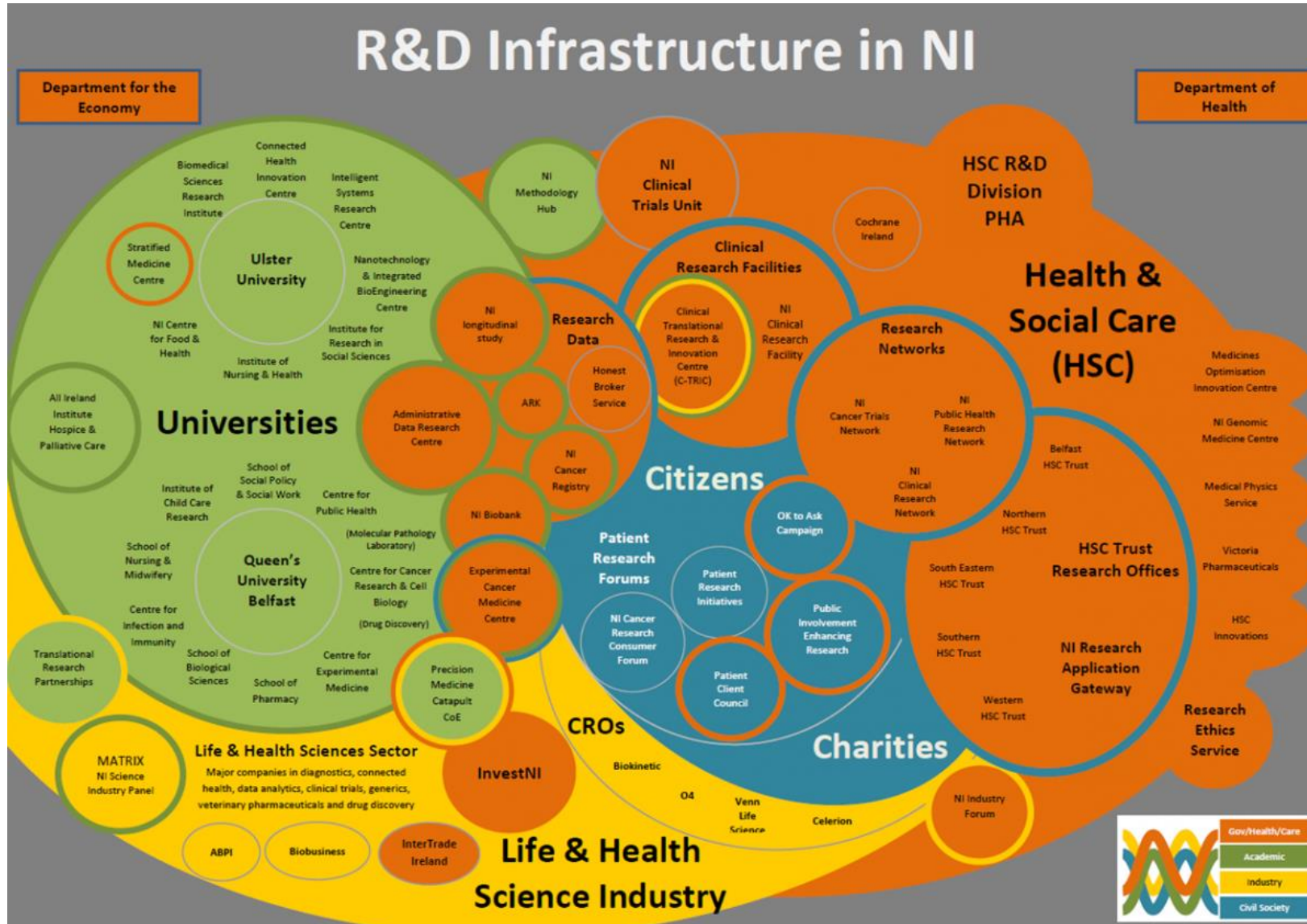
Who are we?
